

BEGELL HOUSE NIH POLICY STATEMENT

Effective April 7, 2008, NIH revised policy requires that NIH-funded authors submit or have submitted on their behalf, their peer-reviewed author manuscripts, to appear on PubMed Central. To help advance science and improve human health, the Policy requires that these papers are accessible to the public on PubMed Central no later than 12 months after final publication.

As a service to our authors Begell House will deposit, to PubMed Central, manuscripts which authors report are NIH funded research. Begell House will send to PubMed Central peer-reviewed manuscript, which was accepted for publication and reflects any changes that the author has agreed to make in response to peer-review comments. All manuscripts for Public Access will be posted 12 months after final publication.

NIH Employees Publishing in Begell House Journals

NIH employees reporting NIH-funded research in any Begell House journals, Begell House will submit to PubMed Central the final peer-reviewed manuscript, which was accepted for publication and sent to our production department, and will reflect any changes made by the author in response to peer-review comments. Begell House will authorize the author manuscript's public access posting 12 months after final publication. Following the deposit by Begell House, authors will receive further communications from the NIH with respect to the submission. It is mandatory for NIH Employees to fill out and send the [NIH Publishing Agreement & Manuscript Cover Sheet](#) to the publisher with initial submission of the manuscript. Although the NIH Publishing Agreement supersedes the Publishers Copyright Agreement, Begell House does require that the Author(s) sign and return both agreements.
